**TITLE** Admission of Resident Students

As a general rule, a pupil's school residence is where his parents live. As long as the parent who has guardianship of the child resides within the school district boundaries, the child is entitled to attend the St. Louis Park Public Schools. Also, any student who has reached the age of majority and resides within the school district may attend the St. Louis Park Public Schools.

At the time of registration, the principal or a designee shall determine and make suitable notation of the residence of the child's parents for those pupils who have not reached the age of majority. If the parents are not living together, the whereabouts of both should be ascertained.

All cases involving question of resident shall be brought to the attention of the school principal. All cases, which after investigation, have been determined to require the payment of tuition shall be reported to the Business Office.
