Diploma Candidate Requirements: Candidates for the diploma study six subjects selected from the subject groups. Normally three subjects are studied at higher level and the remaining three subjects are studied at standard level. All three parts of the core—extended essay, theory of knowledge and creativity, action, service—are compulsory and are central to the philosophy of the Diploma Programme. One subject must be selected from each of groups 1 to 5. The sixth subject may be selected from group 6 or from groups 1 to 5 Must earn 24 Points!

Failing conditions: CAS requirements have not been met. Grades of N, E or 1 awarded. Grade 2 has been awarded three or more times (HL or SL). Grade 3 or below been awarded four or more times (HL or SL). Candidate has gained fewer than 12 points on HL subjects (for candidates who register for four HL subjects, the three highest grades count). Candidate has gained fewer than 9 points on SL subjects.

A bilingual diploma: Complete two languages selected from group 1 with the award of a grade 3 or higher in both.
