**Description:** The School District held a special election on August 9, 2022. Therefore, it must canvass between the third and tenth days after the election. This canvass is an inspection of the returns, a totaling of the votes cast in each precinct, and a declaration by resolution. The duties of the canvassing board are limited to those specified in Minn. Stat. § 204C.32 to 204C.39. (Minn. Stat. § 204C.31, Subd. 3). After the school board has satisfied itself as to the election results, it must prepare an Abstract and Return of Votes Cast and pass the necessary canvassing resolution. The School Board will be asked to canvass and approve the August 9, 2022 Election results.
