Preliminary FY2022 Budget Parameters

Revenue

- ✓ Basic formula +0%
- ✓ Utilize 3-year cohort survival model for enrollment projections
- ✓ Increase fees

Expenditures

- ✓ Budget reductions to hold fund balance to above 10%
- ✓ Include contract settlements and historical patterns
