

Voter Registration Information

Register at the polls when you vote early or on Election Day *OR* register 20 days in advance of the election to save time at the polls.

To be eligible to vote, a person must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on the day of the election (the day they vote)
- United States citizen
- Have maintained residence in Minnesota for at least 20 days before the election
- Properly registered

You must complete the voter registration application in order to register to vote.
